

# Destrier Cats Terms & Conditions

The Seller guarantees that the Cat sold is a genuine registered Pedigree Cat and comes with pedigree, registration papers (or declared), insurance, health check and required vaccinations. Required travel documents if applicable and as advised in contract.

## GENERAL

- a) The Buyer agrees to allow the Seller the right of first refusal should the Buyer decide to sell, relinquish, or transfer the Cat.
- b) Should the Buyer choose to break any of the covenants of this Contract, the Contract will be considered null and void, and the Seller will have the right to repossess the cat with no cost to seller and no refund of monies to the Buyer.
- c) The Buyer agrees that he/she is not acting as or in part of an agent in the purchase of this cat and that the Buyer will not sell this Cat to any agent or pet store.
- d) All monies mentioned in the Contract are in United Kingdom Pounds.
- e) The Contract applies to the original Cat only and is nontransferable to a second party.

## SELLER'S REPRESENTATIONS

- a) The following representation and conditions apply to the aforementioned Cat: The Seller guarantees that the Cat is free of life-threatening diseases or disabilities (i.e., heart murmurs, FIP, etc.) for 72 hours after delivery to the Buyer or collection, unless previously notified in writing. A vaccination certificate and pedigree will be provided upon purchase.
- b) The Buyer has 72 hours to have the Cat examined by a licensed veterinarian. Advised 24 hours. If, as a result of this examination, the veterinarian determines that the Cat is not in good health, then the Buyer shall elect to keep the Cat or return the Cat to the Seller for a refund minus deposit or replacement at the Seller's discretion. If the Buyer elects to return the Cat, the Buyer shall, within 7 days after the date of the signing of this Contract, send to the Seller, by certified mail, a written veterinarian's statement, stating that the Cat was ill when examined. Upon the receipt by the Seller of said statement, the Buyer shall be obligated to return the Cat, the Seller shall be obligated to refund the purchase price minus deposit of the Cat or provide another Cat at the Seller's discretion, and further performance under this Contract shall be null and void. All action taken to return the Cat shall be done with the best interest of the Cat in mind, including temperature at the time of shipment, non-stop flights, best transportation etc. The Buyer shall be solely responsible for all costs and related expenses of returning the Cat to the Seller. Should the Buyer decide to keep the Cat, he forfeits all claims and shall be solely responsible for any and all future veterinarian bills for the Cat.
- c) Ownership of the Cat will be transferred to Buyer for an agreed sale price in contract. It is to be paid as follows: £100 as non-refundable, but transferable deposit on the execution of this agreement and remaining balance paid in full 2 weeks before or on collection or delivery of the cat. Installments are accepted to spread the cost.
- d) If delivery is requested by the Buyer, it shall be air freight or pet courier and prepaid to a designated location. The Seller will be responsible for cost of crate, cost of freight charges, and any and all charges and documentation required for shipping inside and outside the United Kingdom.
- e) The Seller's maximum responsibility is limited to the purchase of the Cat. Any subsequent expenditure is the sole responsibility of the Buyer.
- f) The Breeder makes no guarantee regarding the loss of the Cat because of accidental death, theft, sickness, etc., or any other loss beyond the Breeder's control, except as stated above.
- g) The Buyer agrees to notify the Breeder of any health or temperament problems that develop in this Cat during its life whether it pertains to guarantees or not (i.e. cancer, heart problems, etc.)

## MAINTENANCE

- a) The Buyer agrees to maintain this Cat in good health, provide routine preventative health care including, but not limited to, inoculation, and internal and external parasites.
- b) The Buyer further agrees to provide a proper environment and exercise as indicated in order to maintain this Cat at a proper weight and in good physical shape. A proper diet consists of top-quality Cat food and supplements.
- c) The Buyer agrees to neuter the cat at the age of 6 months or before if on the non active register.
- d) If the cat was sold with show potential. The breeder cannot guarantee show success.
- e) If the cat was placed on the Active register, breeding is permitted. The breeder cannot guarantee breed success
